

# International Invitation - „Weitwinkel – Entdecke den Kontinent“ - 10th National Jamboree 2013

We are cordially inviting you to participate to the BdP National Jamboree 2013 in Immenhausen. We are expecting about 4,500 Guides and Scouts from Germany and all over the world and you should be one of them!

## When?

**25 July to 4 August 2013**

We endeavour to arrange home hospitality before or after the camp if you wish so.

## Where?

The campsite is in Immenhausen near Kassel, in the beautiful district of Hesse about 200 kilometres from Frankfurt. It is surrounded by stunning countryside. The campsite can be reached by train. The closest international airport is Frankfurt (FRA), providing plenty of international flight destinations. There are also convenient train-connections from Hamburg.



## Who are we?

Bund der Pfadfinderinnen und Pfadfinder – BdP – is the interdenominational Guide and Scout Association in Germany. We are member of both World Scout/Guide Organisations, WAGGGS and WOSM.



## Who can take part?

The camp is aimed at Guides and Scouts aged between 12 and 16 years old. The size of your group should be ideally around 10 girls and/or boys, including leaders. Each international group will be teamed-up with a German partner group for the duration of the camp.

## What will happen during the camp?

The camp's theme „Weitwinkel“ in German means roughly „wide angle – discover the continent“ and is a reference to the view we have. The view over the world and the people around us. We would like to step off the usual trails and discover our continent Europe and the world. It's about the history of Europe, European culture and how to design the future.

But we will also have a look around the region of Immenhausen and discover the world aside the caved trails. Besides the world around us we would like to rediscover ourselves. Experience our association, our cultures and traditions. And this expedition we would like to venture with Girl Guides and Boy Scouts from around the world. Find new friends and see the world through their eyes.

## What do you have to bring with you?

Each participant shall bring his/her personal camping equipment including sleeping bag and foam pad, as well as tents, cooking and other camping equipment. If you have any transportation problems, please contact us well in advance so that we can assist you in making your arrangements. Your BdP Partner group might also be able to supply you with parts of equipment, if needed.



### How much does it cost?

The camp fee is €135,00 per person if it is fully paid before 31 March 2013. From 1 April 2013 the camp fee will be €155,00 per person. This fee includes all activities during the camp, i.e. camping fee, food (partially), badge and a camp brochure. A facility to buy food on the campsite will also be available. Each patrol / group should organise their own menu and cook for themselves (or in cooperation with the hosting group). Please allow approx. € 3-5 per person and day for food in addition to the camp fee. All BdP groups will travel to the camp with special trains, specifically arranged for the camp. You are also invited to make use of this great offer with or without your partner group. If you do use the train, the price per person will be €210,00 if paid by 31 March 2013, and €230,00 thereafter.



### Do I require an insurance?

Each group has to make own arrangements for health insurance and ensure that all participants are appropriately covered. Medical and hospital treatment is very expensive in Germany, if not insured!

### What language is spoken at the camp?

Written information will be sent in German and English. The main language during the camp will be German but translation into English and possibly other languages will be offered for all main events during the camp as well. Most Germans speak English and quite often French. Our international camp team will also be able to assist with other languages.

### International Service Team?

We invite Ranger and Rover aged 18+ to join our international Service Team. The camp fee is similar to the normal participants fee. Please contact us for further information
