The International evening offers all guest groups and international project groups of the BdP the possibility to present them to the camp.

Bear in mind that the International Evening is already on the 3rd day of the camp! Hardly any time to prepare something on the camp. So do a lot of things at home!

Here is what we expect from you:

The International Evening has the following parts:

1. Presentation of InterRegio Scouting Traditions

- a. Interregional Spot
- b. Interregional Games
- c. Interregional Arena

More information about the topics:

To 1: Presentation of the InterRegio Scouting Traditions

At the market square international guests, their host groups and BdP international project groups present themselves. The participants of the International Evening play a version of Scattergories and collect information about foreign countries.

The InterRegional spot:

Each international group will get the possibility to present them in a small pavilion.

Examples for presentations:

- Regional maps/flags/pennant
- Scouting specials of your region
- Camp sites with addresses, scenic attractions, sights
- Regional things a scouting group must see

ATTENTION: There will be no energy/ technical devices provided

The InterRegional Games:

In front of your pavilion the participants of the camp get active with your short games and get the opportunity to learn new games and get to know Guides and Scouts from other countries. Target is to have the biggest possible mix of participants

The InterRegional Arena:

There will be special areas for your shows to entertain your visitors. It's up to you how you present yourselves and your region as long as you do it in a scouting way.

These shows should be about 10min long. There will be more than one arena with parallel shows. Because of that there will be a lot of movement and no statics.





Examples:

- Musical performances i.e. bagpipe, didgeridoo, drums...
- Regional dances wearing traditional clothes
- Jonglage

Important:

The past showed that it doesn't make sense to offer food to 4000 people. We therefore ask you to offer culinary delicacies at your sub camp. Please ask the sub camp leader and the café operators.

The International Evening ends with a central ending.

2: International Song Battle:

The best group opens the International Evening with their song. Put your interpretation of the camp song online (i.e. on YouTube or vimeo) and send the link to: bundeslager@pfadfinden.de (subject: International Song Battle).

3: Carriage on cloth width

The international meeting between your groups should reflect the camp motto „Discover the continent“. Each group designs a symbolic carriage on a cloth width.

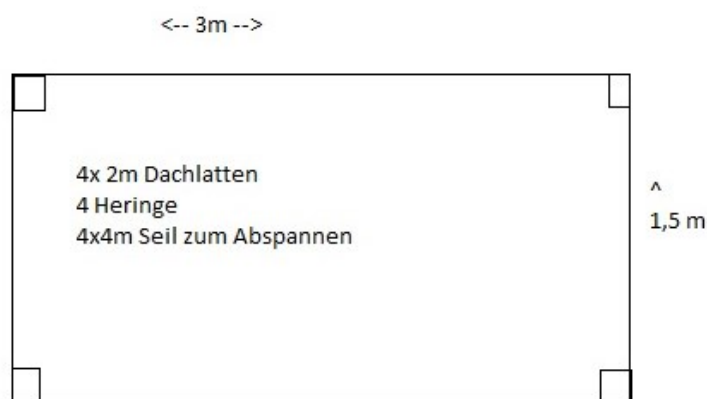
These carriages will be shown at the International Evening.

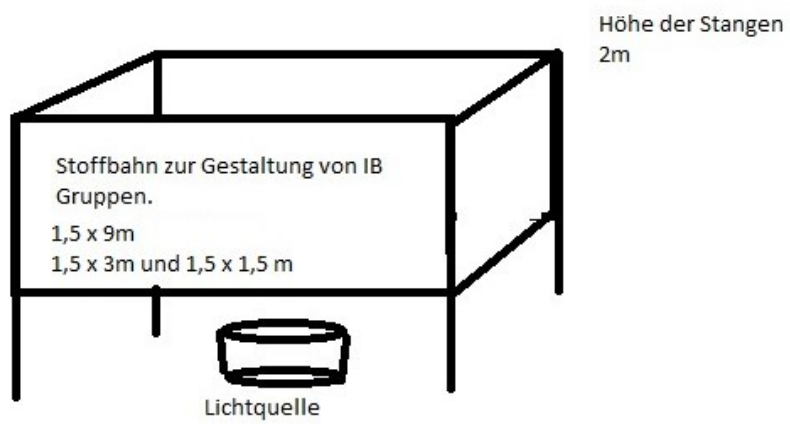
Please get a white cloth width at home. Important, it has to be 9m long and 1,5m wide. The design of the carriage walls should be done during group meetings or at a meeting before the camp. You are free about the way you would like to design - you decide if you will do a collage, a comic about the region of your guests or a collection of information. Remember that everything should be waterproof.

Your BdP host group will do the same with you as a partner group. The cloth width will be built up and “parked” at the sub camp. One side shows the view of the guest group and the region it comes from and vice versa.

It will show wishes, experiences or prejudices about the partner, which you will discuss and change during your time at the camp.
